



## CRIMINAL RESPONSE SECURITY & SAFETY ACT

We would like to provide you with important information regarding the reporting of missing persons or criminal activity while on board. In the event of such incidents, we strongly urge you to immediately contact Guest Services team by dialing 99. Our dedicated hosts are ready to provide you with the necessary support and assistance.

For cases involving a missing US national or any serious incidents, as defined by the Cruise Vessel Security and Safety Act 2010 (including homicide, suspicious death, kidnapping, assault with bodily injury, sexual assaults as defined by federal laws, firing or tampering with the vessel, or theft of money or property exceeding \$10,000), it is crucial that you report the incident to the FBI without delay. Please ensure that the US Coast Guard is also notified. We have provided the relevant contact numbers for your convenience:

These reporting requirements apply to incidents that occur within US waters, as well as on the high seas or in foreign waters if the assailant or victim is a US national, allowing the FBI to exercise jurisdiction. It is important to note that each visited nation and the vessel's registry may impose additional reporting obligations.

At Explora Journeys, we are committed to cooperating fully with law enforcement agencies and will report any criminal allegations as required. Moreover, for incidents that occur in foreign waters or ports, you may seek assistance from the closest US Embassy/Consulate.
