

3 Greek Classic Corfu

Revel in a heady mix of Ionian landmarks amid spirit-boosting views. Sit beneath the iconic Liston arches in the atmospheric Old Town, span Spianada Square where skinny streets radiate off past churches and cross the moat to the Old Fortress. Slip into homey tavernas where chefs work meze finesse, skip aboard a caique, mountain bike, horse ride or shop ceramics. Head for staggering Paleokastritsa views strewn with pines, firs and sleepy Corfiot villages, bird spot in lush wetlands and climb Mount Pantokrator to capture rare icons. An enticing and scenic jaunt through an eternal Greek classic.






O DAY CROATIA

4 Distinctive Dubrovnik

Marvel at this chic walled city paved with a wealth of aristocratic palazzi, ancient forts and epic Adriatic views. Enter grand Pile Gate to lose yourself in intricate alleys, stage-set squares, museums and baroque churches. Ease out of town to kayak around sturdy ramparts, taste Dalmatian wines in the Konavle countryside, and visit archaic Cavtat and history-packed Mostar. Escape the crowds to cacti-clad Lokrum for a spot of yoga and botanical walking, or join in to graze at trendy restaurants on the rocks. It's no wonder the glitterati flock to the strength of this charming and inspiring medieval Dalmatian marvel.

5

Queen Ancona of the Italian Adriatic

Port: Ancona Arrival Method: DOCK Arrival: 10:00 Departure: 20:00

Memories of maritime glory echo through the winding streets of charming Ancona, where handsome palazzos and elegant churches bear witness. Established by the Greeks on Italy's outer elbow, the ancient harbour anchors undulating hillsides and rugged Adriatic coastline peppered with fishermen's caves and pearlescent beaches. Cast your eyes towards the rising sun through the Arch of Trajan, Roman gateway to the east, and watch life unfold at ageless waterfront trattorias and cobbled piazzas. Lion-flanked San Ciriaco Cathedral stands sentinel on a hill above the port, rewarding those who make the journey with oil painting scenes as sunset bathes all in an amber glow. Further north, the UNESCO historic centre of Urbino beckons with its Renaissance walls that survive virtually intact.





DAY ITALY

6 Waltz into Venice

Delve into ancient palaces, century-old galleries, and modern-day exhibits as you whirl through Venice. Walk through masterpieces, catch an opera, gaze at medieval buildings, blow Murano glass and drift down the Grand Canal by gondola to visit churches, convents and campi "squares" that vary in spirit and scale. Cross hump-backed bridges, reach teeming Piazza San Marco's Basilica and Doge's Palace, or duck down passages to escape reality. From palazzos to perfumeries and the must-see Bridge of Sighs, you're only moments from a place of beauty in this liquid-gold city of treasures.

7 Dalmatian Daydreams in Split

Sheltered by mountains and hills of pine, Split casts a sirenic spell, its terracotta-tiled rooftops spilling straight down to the sparkling Adriatic. Wander within the ancient walls of Diocletian's seafront palace to its collonaded courtyard and cathedral, the sinuous streets and sunny squares abuzz with cafes and shops, and everyday life ongoing amid the palace's atmospheric alleyways. From here, peoplewatch over coffee on the Saint Tropez-esque Riva promenade; climb to the hilltop park, small churches hidden along the way, for a sundowner; or seek the sandy Bacvice beach, swimming the shallows as Splicani play picigin (ballgame), and perfecting the Dalmatian art of fjaka, the sweetness of doing nothing.

8 The Jewel of the Balkan Fjords

Comely Kotor Bay, a lesser-travelled amphitheatre etched into the Adriatic coast of Montenegro, welcomes with hypnotic jade waters encircled by emerald-crowned slopes. Sheltered in the fjord's angelic embrace, Kotor Old Town beckons as a fairy-tale city whose formidable walls, Romanesque churches and medieval bastions have witnessed the highs and lows of masked carnivals and devastating earthquakes. Italian and Mediterranean influences flavour the cuisine, where gelato and *brodetto* accompany fresh Adriatic seafood. Uphill, the Church of our Lady of Remedy affords spectacular views of Kotor's red-tiled UNESCO World Heritage rooftops, a manmade jewel amongst landscapes where the inspired will wander.







Cape Sounion and the Temple of Poseidon

Cited as the place where the grief-stricken ancient King Aegeus cast himself into the Aegean, giving his name to the sea in the process, Cape Sounion is still encircled by mesmerising, turquoise water. Before arrival in Sounion, you'll be driven between the marinas of Phaleron, Glyfada and Vouliagmeni on a route that offers spectacular views. At the top of the cape stand the remaining 15 Doric columns of the Temple of Poseidon, which has stood since 440 BC. A guide will show you the towering columns up close—one still bearing the etched signature of the English poet Lord Byron—which gaze across the high clifftops of the peninsula of Attica.

Visit Krka National Park

Your first stop in blissful Krka National Park is Lozovac. From here, you will explore the natural cascade barriers of the Park. This tour will take you to the most attractive part of the park— the Skradinski Buk waterfalls. The highest fall is 46 m (151 ft) high, which makes it the highest gypsum barrier in Europe. Above the falls, there is a large plateau that offers spectacular views. During your exploration, a visit is made to a small ethnological exhibition and the old mill, which is still functioning, demonstrating how it was used for grinding. We then head to Plastovo village and the home of the Sladić family, who will walk you through a tasting of their wines at Ante Sladić Vino. Produced using time-honoured methods and only indigenous grapes, these wines are unique to this region.
