

1 The Fusion of Istanbul



3 Unbeknownst Bozcaada

An incognito Turkish island – and 17 islets – in the Aegean. Cited by Homer and with whispers of Troy, Bozcaada has long been at the mercy of Mediterranean power struggles – once Byzantine, ceded to the Venetians in ransom and then Ottoman, it is now a seductive intermix of influences and popular summer playground for Istanbulites. Pilgrim to the old windmill and beautifully preserved castle, then retreat to soft sand beaches with chilly crystalline water and colourful cafés spilling onto slim cobblestone streets, where residents drink wine from the island's extensive vineyards. This is no backwater though: expect vibrant cooking, cocktails and coffee thanks to cool, young islanders bringing a contemporary verve.

4 Immerse Yourself in Bodrum

Imagine an old-world fishing town with high society appeal. Explore breathtaking sights on the sunlit Peninsula of the turquoise coast. Soak up the town's buzzing energy; shop, eat, relax and explore. Pay respect to one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, savour fresh fish and meze and sip coffee of toe-tingling strength. Delve into captivating landscapes bursting with nature; the Bafa Lake, olive groves, bougainvillea and hundreds of different bird species. Feel the wind in your hair on a private gullet as you voyage to crystal clear coves of the Aegean. Lasting memories abound.

5 Remarkable Rhodes

Port: Rhodes Arrival Method: DOCK Arrival: 08:00 Departure: 20:00

Rising from the sea like a jewel, the island of Rhodes was a gift from Zeus to Helios, the sun god. A sun-kissed home to Cicero and Caesar whose rhetoric and thinking still echo along stone-paved lanes and the UNESCO-listed Old Town. Follow the footsteps of the Knights of St. John and their Turkish conquerors who both left fascinating monuments, fountains and shady squares. Soak up the buzzing energy and be gently tempted to step back in time. Pay respect at the pinkish Suleiman Mosque with its tall minaret then seek serenity at the Byzantine Church or heavenly views where perfectly positioned white houses are dotted high into the hills. Whilst you wander, lean into the legend of the 100-foot Colossus, a wonder of the world, replaced now with twin bronze deer that guard the Mandraki Harbour.

6 Amorgos Legends & Soulful Sunsets

Arrival: 08:00 Departure: 21:00

Snow-white buildings pop in blinding contrast to the cerulean blue of the Aegean in Katapola, where fishermen sip raki in waterside tavernas, and the perfume of citrus drifts down cobbled streets. Hike between sleepy Cycladic villages and Mycenaean ruins as wild goats graze on sun-baked hillsides and stop to explore pretty chapels where locals tell tales of Greek myths and legends. Below the waves, rainbow-coloured marine life darts through crystalline waters punctuated by sea caves and rusting wrecks. Succumb to sunset in charming Chora, the island capital of Amorgos.


7 Have a Quiet Moment in Paros

Port: Paros Arrival Method: TENDER

Arrival: 08:00 Departure: 20:00

Unveil picturesque Paros' unadorned charms from ancient remains to traditional tavernas and sweet villages and blue-domed churches to a bounty of blonde-sand beaches. Head out to Parikia to find the awe-inspiring AD326 Byzantine monastery or take a ferry across to explore caves in the rugged natural beauty of Antiparos. Walk through the island's ancient archaeological history at the tiny museum and lose yourself in the labyrinth of lanes at the old Venetian port of Náoussa. Banish any tension on a sunlounger, then breeze through home-cooked mezze feasts in white-washed tavernas. Windsurf, kite-surf, dive, swim au naturel and enjoy a network of walking trails. Somehow Páros has managed to preserve more of the soft spirit than some of her Cyclade cousins.

8 Progressive Athens

Port: Piraeus (Athens) Arrival Method: DOCK Arrival: 07:00 Departure: 19:00

Athenians don't live in the past. Ahead of its time, Athens exudes glamour and a sense of possibility - housing galleries, gelaterias, bijoux boutiques alongside a plethora of museums. And you can't help but marvel at the archaeological wonders of the Acropolis and the Parthenon. Stroll through vibrant streets and markets, dance at buzzing bouzoukia, sing along in tavernas. At night, head to the harbour, where dimly lit bars serve the local ice cold beer. And, as you inhale the salty air and watch Greek fishing boats peacefully depart for their catch, reflect on this ancient city's progressive attitude.

9 Patmos of Revelations

Port: Patmos Arrival Method: DOCK Arrival: 08:00 Departure: 19:00

A tiny island with a big reputation. Voyage to this discreet island where few go. Famed for being the discerning guests' paradise; sunkissed beaches, clear waters shielded by protective coves and undeniably warm local hospitality. Classically Greek with beautiful, mountainous views of perfectly positioned white houses dotted high into the hills. Known as the Land of Legends, St John was said to have written his Book of Revelations here. Quiet but with a powerful energy, you'll understand why this island was named "Letois", after the goddess and huntress of deer, Artemis, daughter of Leto. It was believed that Patmos came into existence thanks to her divine intervention.

11 Greek Classic Corfu

Port: Corfu Arrival Method: DOCK Arrival: 09:00 Departure: 22:00

Revel in a heady mix of Ionian landmarks amid spirit-boosting views. Sit beneath the iconic Liston arches in the atmospheric Old Town, span Spianada Square where skinny streets radiate off past churches and cross the moat to the Old Fortress. Slip into homey tavernas where chefs work meze finesse, skip aboard a caique, mountain bike, horse ride or shop ceramics. Head for staggering Paleokastritsa views strewn with pines, firs and sleepy Corfiot villages, bird spot in lush wetlands and climb Mount Pantokrator to capture rare icons. An enticing and scenic jaunt through an eternal Greek classic.



12 In-Vogue Otranto

Port: Otranto Arrival Method: TENDER

Arrival: 08:00 Departure: 17:00

On the heel of Italy's boot on an eponymous strait connecting the Adriatic and the Ionian, Otranto is one of in-vogue Puglia's most picturesque towns. Keeping glorious watch over the water is the glorious Castello Aragonese, its moat and stunning perimeter walls a reminder of a tumultuous, gory history thanks to Otranto's strategic position at the heart of the Mediterranean. The Cathedral di Santa Maria Annunziata, with its relics of martyrs, mosaic floors and rose windows, begs a visit before walking the wide promenades to excellent seafront restaurants and the beautiful sandy beach with shallow turquoise waters.

13 The Zing of Zadar

Head back in time through impressive walls and city gates to a treasure trove of architecture and natural beauty. Hike, ride or climb through an enchanting heartland of national parks; cruise up pine-cloaked rivers, swim under a crescent of cascades and spot sapphire dragonflies over emerald pools. Dance across the Monument to the Sun, follow whispers to remote turquoise shallows and hear the rhythm of the ocean from an underwater Sea Organ. Visit the Venetian towers, atmospheric wells and a superbly carved Romanesque Cathedral or climb a bell tower with far-reaching views. Infused in sunshine, Venetian charm and (according to Hitchcock) the world's best sunset - intriguing Zadar is a cultural gem resplendent.

Dinner and Dancing in Istanbul



Exploring Historic Galata

Return to a time when Karaköy was called Galata as you see some of Istanbul's oldest buildings of Roman and Ottoman origin. Bodrum Castle and Sailing on a Luxury Gulet

The 15th-century Bodrum Castle was built by the Knights Hospitaller using stone from the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus—one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Today, it holds the Bodrum Museum of Underwater Archaeology, an extraordinary collection of shipwrecks and artefacts recovered from the seabed. Later, you'll put out to sea in a luxurious wooden watercraft called a *gulet*, which is up to 30 m (98.4 ft) long and has multiple masts. There's no finer way to visit the wild coves of the Bodrum Peninsula than aboard such a vessel, which has plied these waters for centuries. Swim and snorkel in the idyllic bays, and enjoy a traditional lunch onboard, accompanied by a chilled glass of wine and some light music.



Architecture and Spices in Istanbul

Fatih, Istanbul's central district, is home to ancient Ottoman history and buzzing modern vibrancy. After a drive into the heart of the city, stroll through the lively streets until you reach the Sultan Ahmet Camii (Blue Mosque). It was constructed during the early 17th century during the reign of Sultan Ahmed I. The mosque is famous for the striking blue tilework which adorns its interior walls, giving it the name 'Blue Mosque'. Then, discover one of the oldest and largest covered markets: Grand Bazaar. Discover the Rüstem Paşa Camii (Rustem Pasha Mosque) a dazzling Ottoman mosque tucked away behind the markets, with a vast collection of decorative tiles. At the ancient Acropolis of Rhodes, you will have the chance to admire the remains of the ancient stadium of Rhodes, just next to the temple of Apollo, the Odeon, the Stoa Building, the Nymphaeum and the Temple of Athena Polias and Zeus Polieus. The stadium is 210 m (600 ft) in length, with some of its parts very well-preserved even today. Back when the Olympic Stadium, Rhodes, was in its prime, athletes would compete for fame and glory. Return to Rhodes' old town—Medieval City of Rhodes—where you'll continue your tour on foot through narrow, cobblestone streets. Follow the Street of the Knights past colourful shops, the 15th-century Hospital of the Knights and the Palace of the Grand Master of the Knights of Rhodes. Later, visit Path of Gods, which is housed in a building combining medieval architecture with modern design. It was built to house and shelter replicas of artefacts. Beside Path of Gods is an excavation that started in 1976 and was completed in the 1990s, unearthing relics dating back to the Hellenistic Period. You will have the opportunity to familiarise yourself with Rhodian history and culture through replicas of ancient war engines, ancient technology and ancient toys. After the guided tour, you will enjoy a 20-minute high-definition movie showing the history of ancient sports and Rhodian Olympic winners. Come to experience a journey of 2,500 years in 40 minutes!
