

1 Hidden Rome

The artistic-minded can enjoy fashion aristocracy, street art, vespa jaunts to The Appian Way and toss coins into fountains. Or you can stroll by appointment to Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel and the Pope's private quarters at the Vatican. Explore the historic ruins of The Colosseum, Caravaggio churches, the Spanish Steps and The Pantheon. Learn how to make pasta the true Italian way, hunt truffles, nibble gelato, sip coffee and sink into a 3000 year old pool for a wellness experience. an ode to homespun pasta at a Renaissance piazza. When in Rome, fusing old with new makes it simple to indulge in whatever you like.

2 A Siren's Song of Sorrento

Seductive Greek Sirens still sing from Sorrento's shores and lure us into her astonishing beauty of Vesuvian sites, Amalfi hikes and a wealth of pretty Positano pleasures. Wander maze-like Centro Storico laced with hidden gardens and historic churches then prepare your palate for old-school pizzerias and lemony gelato in picturesque Piazza Tasso. Peer down into the Valle dei Mulini or venture to Lattari Mountain trails and dig into Italy's most famous sites: ancient Pompeii and Herculaneum. Hop a yacht across the Bay of Naples to chic Capri or round Sorenntina Penisola for ravishing Ravello's terraced gardens. Between sips of luscious limoncello and a wealth of wonders, Sorrento smoulders with eternal dolce vita glamour.

3 Linger Longer in Lipari

Port: Lipari (Aeolian Islands) Arrival Method: TENDER

Arrival: 08:00 Departure: 20:00

Black obsidian has lured merchants to Lipari, the largest of the Aeolian Islands, since Neolithic times. The volcanic forces that forged it burst from the wild isle in whooshing fumaroles and thermal springs, and a hike to Quattrocchi viewpoint reveals enchanting views of lost world neighbour Vulcano, smoking Stromboli and Sicily's Mount Etna in the distance. Pastel buildings circle Lipari's pretty harbour, where fishing boats moor beneath the imposing citadel, built after the town was sacked by pirates in 1544. Trace Lipari's history in the Aeolian Archaeological Museum, take your pick from a handful of pristine beaches or sit back and feast on Sicilian cannoli and arancini.

4 A Taste of Trapani

Fully invest in la dolce vita. Savour exciting historical sites and authentic Sicilian life in the City of Salt and Sail. Admire some of the best-preserved relics of Greece's Golden Age at the UNESCO-acclaimed ancient city of Agrigento. Stock up on locally produced Ortigia and sample Sicilian classics passed down through generations. Visit famed Erice for one of the most beautiful viewpoints in Sicily, chopper or sail across to other Aeolian islands and visit the mineral-rich salines. Journey up to Monreale to ponder crumbling hilltop alleys and the Norman cathedral depicting Sicily of old and amble through orange, olive and almond groves. Life moves slowly here for Trapani has an old-world Mediterranean soul.

5 A Taste of Siracusa

Dip in a Mediterranean mass of rich history, cuisine and abundant nature. Wander through historic cities, Roman sites, Greek temples and expansive vineyards. Skirt around simmering Mount Etna's fertile lava lands, survey Grecian archaeology inland at Valle Dei Templi Grecian, seek out tumbled ruins at sea-facing Selinunte and drop in to Casale to admire ornate mosaics. Attend an Etna Rosso wine tasting, head for peace at the nature reserve and liven up at the Baroque old town of Sciacca. And for a final taste of Sicily, feast on olive oil drenched pasta - you won't leave this honey-hued region unfulfilled.

6 Time Travel in Valetta

Unearth the Med's master of restoration and renovation behind honey-hued Valetta's fortified walls. Strewn with a mass of well-preserved history - head back in time to hand-carved shelters, a maze of subterranean tombs and stone-age temples. Discover war secrets beneath the limestone streets, skim the Grand Harbour aboard a dghajsa, step into state history and get your fill of art and Fat Ladies in museums. But it's not all ancient history - watch buzzing bars spill out onto limestone alleys, treat yourself to Michelin-starred Maltese cuisine, neighbourhood watch and dive over wrecks. Malta may be Europe's tiniest capital, but she packs a might punch.

8 Tarragona's World Heritage Highlights

Once an important Roman capital, Tarragona's wealth of antiquities has seen the Catalonia city crowned a UNESCO World Heritage site. There's the standout waterfront 2nd-century amphitheatre and a well-preserved Roman circus. But wander the charming narrow, cobblestone streets and cafe-lined squares and you'll stumble upon more beautiful ruins – ancient forum walls and soaring columns – layered amidst modern city life. Outside the city ramparts, take time to pilgrim 4km north and walk across the glorious two-tier Ferres Aqueduct built by Emperor Augustus and if visiting in October, witness a Tarragona tradition at the city's annual castells competition, where teams from across the country gather in the old bullring to create human towers between six and ten tiers high.







Without Mount Etna, there would be no Sicily. Europe's most active volcano is inseparable from the Sicilian identity, having shaped the island's topography, culture and aura for millennia.
