

Artist César Manrique put little Arrecife on the map. Explore his eclectic works in underground caverns, fabulous murals and his former home in nearby Tahíche, or sate your artistic appetite in contemporary gallery MIAC and the surreal underwater world of sculptor Jason de Caires Taylor. The spectral landscape of Timanfaya, once a seething sea of lava shattered by volcanic eruptions, is ripe for 4x4 exploration, while the year-round waves of Playa de Famara invite beginners and pros alike to grab a surfboard and take the plunge.

The cobblestone capital of La Isla Bonita - the lesser travelled northwestern outcrop of the Canaries - was once among the most important ports in the Spanish empire. Uncover its history at a handful of museums, including the cloistered Insular Museo of Natural History, feel the Caribbean thread in the sugarcane stacks at the covered market, and stroll narrow streets with hanging wooden balconies, every house painted a different colour, to grand colonial mansions and the Plaza Espana, hustling bustling heart of Santa Cruz.

7 Gravity Defying Funchal

Funchal's web of ancient streets spills down from lofty heights. Ride the cable car up to the exotic gardens of Monte Palace at its peak, where peacocks prowl high above the Atlantic. Swirl a glass of ambercoloured Madeira at a café overlooking chequerboard-tiled Praça do Município and prepare to explore lush could forests crisscrossed by hiking trails and black sand beaches below jungle-covered cliffs.

Rising from the sea like a titanic fin, the Rock of Gibraltar is a primordial sentinel that guards the entrance to the Mediterranean; the European Pillar of Hercules faces its African twin across the Strait of Gibraltar. From its top, the coast of Morocco shimmers in a desert haze, and eagle eyes spot dolphins dancing below. Criss-crossed by centuries-old siege tunnels and UNESCO-listed caves, the Rock has captured the imaginations of artists and would-be conquerors for centuries. A cable car makes short work of the journey to the top, where old artillery batteries and panoramic lookouts are guarded by legions of Barbary macaques.





Explore the Valley of a Thousand Palms

Unleash your inner explorer to discover Lanzarote's enigmatic beauty, from the soaring peaks of Peñas del Chache to the peaceful streets of Haria. Begin your adventure with a climb to the island's highest point, which offers views as far as the horizon, where the turquoise sky meets the golden expanse of Famara Beach. Then, hike through the Valley of a Thousand Palms to Haria, a village where time seems to stand still. Here, against a backdrop of volcanic grandeur, there's time for coffee and reflection. The journey intensifies when you step into the Cueva de los Verdes lava tube and cave, and a labyrinth sculpted by primeval volcanic activity.

César Manrique – Where Nature and Art Combine

The tour begins with a visit to Fundación César Manrique, a foundation focused on showcasing Manrique's strong personal commitment to his work and his ecological vision. It was this vision that led him to reconvert a set of volcanic bubbles into his own home in El Taro de Tahíche, now the foundation's home. Touring Manrique's rooms, decorated with works of his own art and pieces from his private collection, is the best way to glimpse the mind and talent of this incomparable artist. Next, see Lagomar, a museum, restaurant, bar and private hillside residence that stands out due to its great natural and architectural appeal, on a National Geographic visit. Situated in the village of Nazaret in the municipality of Costa Teguise, the residence is built into an ancient volcanic quarry, using its lava as construction material. Lagomar is the surrounding nature, as the existing tunnels, recesses and terraces were formed from the molten lava released by a volcanic eruption. Lagomar perfectly reflects the spirit of Manrique, with a large part of it completed by his friend Jesús Soto. While at Lagomar, you'll meet the property's current owner, architect Beatriz van Hoff, who will share information about the property and her friendship with César Manrique. Travelling to the north of the island, see some of the mobiles Manrique created as part of his sculpture work, inspired by the windmills abundant in Lanzarote's past (Manrique called these mobile structures 'wind toys'). Enjoy a guided tour of Mirador del Río, the site built by Manrique to verify his hypothesis that humans could respect nature's essence and at the same time achieve an artistic and functional space for the tourism economy. Elevated on one of the cliffs of Famara, 470 m (1,542 ft) above the sea, this location was previously used as a defence point for the island. Enjoy a glass of local wine or other refreshment whilst taking in the scenic splendour that inspired Manrique.

Cave Exploration and Mischievous Macaques

From Europa Point, gaze upon the mesmerising blues of the Mediterranean as it laps against the jagged cliff edges of Gibraltar. Then venture inside the rock to explore St Michael's Cave, where stalactites and stalagmites cast their shadows on the walls as you walk through its tunnel complex. Amidst the historic grandeur of the Charles V Wall, encounter the impish Barbary macaques, whose mischief and agility have long captivated locals and visitors. 



The method, adapted due to a series of volcanic eruptions that forever altered the soil, is hard work, but has led to a beautiful landscape that is known for its unique way of growing grapes from the volcanic ash. While at the private home bodega, sample some of the delicious wines produced there, where the local varietal, La Malvasía Volcánica, is considered to be amongst the oldest white grapes in the world. On the walk back to the pier, be sure to admire the unique volcanic landscape and the area's peculiar wine plantations with a newly found admiration for the local ingenuity in adapting to the environment whilst keeping local traditions alive.






