

# 10 Cagliari: Sardinia's Historic Capital

Cagliari fans out from the steep slopes of Il Castello, the hilltop citadel built by Pisan rulers in the 13th century, home to the opulent Cathedral of Santa Maria and bloody Elephant Tower, where trophy heads once hung. The seven-kilometre expanse of Poetto Beach unfurls from the Devil's Saddle (Sella del Diavolo) on St. Elia promontory, past a string of beachfront eateries where legendary Sardinian seafood is enhanced by crisp chilled Vermentino. Across the waves, the irresistible waters of Capo Carbonara Marine Reserve teem with colourful coral fans and kaleidoscopic sea creatures.





## Ancient Torralba d'en Salort and Vibrant Mahón

Savour the aromas of *tapas* bars as you're led through the artistry of Spanish cuisine, and sample mouthwateringly authentic *pintxos*, unapologetically spiced and alive with flavour. Continue to Palma's old town to marvel at the Gothic architecture and try Mallorca's trademark pastry, the *ensaimada*, which has delicate layers of dough and a sweet filling.

Oater, head to the family-run Finca Treurer, a centuries-old estate that produces award-winning extravirgin olive oil. Learn about their sustainable farming methods and sample the bitter, peppery olive oil with some delicious *tapas* and a glass of wine.

Visit LA Organic, a ten-hectare olive farm where you'll be guided through the sun-dappled plantation. After a guided meditation, relax over a sumptuous brunch amidst the ancient olive trees.
