


## 4 Charlotte Amalie Charms

## Grand'Rivière Adventure and Rum Tasting

Experience a unique blend of history, culture and nature through the 'North Atlantic' area of Martinique. From your vehicle, discover the ruins and Saint-Pierre, once nicknamed 'Little Paris'. On your way to the island's Atlantic coast, you will pass at the foot of Mount Pelée, the island's only active volcano. With a bit of luck, you might catch a glimpse of its slopes and summit in the distance. Your first stop is at the Rhum J.M. distillery, one of the island's most renowned. There, during a guided tour, you will uncover the secrets of making agricultural rum. The visit concludes with a workshop featuring tasting techniques and rum presentations, and the crafting of the iconic cocktail called ti-punch (hand-on). Afterwards, head to the northernmost town of Martinique: Grand'Rivière. Discover a very small historic family distillery founded in 1671, and its enchanting botanical garden with more than 400 plant species: blue fern, yellow cane, passion fruit, bamboo, latanier palm, orchid, mango tree and coconut tree. By the estate's pool, conclude this experience with a presentation and tasting of fresh, tropical fruits.
